

Below is information about how Sublime Streamline LTD and its affiliates (“we”) use cookies and other similar technology on this website.

By continuing to use this website you agree that we can place cookies and other similar technology on your device, including mobile device. By continuing to use your mobile device to access this website, you agree that the following information may be collected: your unique device identifier, mobile device IP address, information about your device’s operating system, mobile carrier and your location information (to the extent permissible under applicable law).

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your computer or mobile device when you visit a site and allow a site to recognize your device.

Why do we use cookies and similar technologies?

Cookies do a lot of different jobs, such as letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences and generally improving the user experience. Some companies employ cookies to ensure that the advertisements you see online are more relevant to you and your interests.

Does Streamline use cookies for marketing and analytics?

We may use information collected from our cookies to identify user behaviour and traffic sources into our public websites. We do this only to the extent legally permissible in certain jurisdictions.

Some of the cookies we use don't collect information that identifies a visitor. For example –

- Performance cookies (see below)
- User behaviour cookies deployed across our online products

In other cases we can associate cookie information with an identifiable individual. For example –

- Automatic emails delivered to you as part of our product offering (in-application emails) to enable us to track the information delivered and maintain security of information
- If we send you a targeted email which includes web beacons, cookies or similar technologies we will know whether you open, read, or delete the message
- When you click a link in a marketing e-mail you receive from Streamline, we will also use a cookie to log what pages you view and what content you download from our websites, even if you are not registered at or signed into our site
- **Combining and analysing personal data** – As described above, we may combine data from publicly available sources, and from our different e-mail, website, and personal interactions with you. We may combine this data to better assess your experience with Streamline’s products and service offerings and to perform the other activities described throughout our privacy policy.

Do you use any cookies from third party companies?

Some cookies we use are from third party companies, such as Google Analytics, to provide us with web analytics and intelligence about our sites. These companies use programming code to collect information about your interaction with our sites, such as the pages you visit, the links you click on and how long you are on our sites. This code is only active while you are on Streamline websites. Does Streamline use any non-cookie tracking technologies?

In some instances we use server-side application analytics. This provides us with an additional level of understanding on how our users interact with Streamline products and services. We do not collect any personal information during this tracking.

What if I don’t want cookies?

By using our site you agree that we can place cookies on your device as explained below. If you want to remove existing cookies from your

device you can do this using your browser options. If you want to block future cookies being placed on your device you can change your browser settings to do this. Please bear in mind that deleting and blocking cookies will have an impact on your user experience as parts of the site may no longer work. Unless you have adjusted your browser settings to block cookies, our system will issue cookies as soon as you visit our site or click on a link in a targeted email that we have sent you, even if you have previously deleted our cookies.
